Nursery: Available from 9:45 –11:15 am

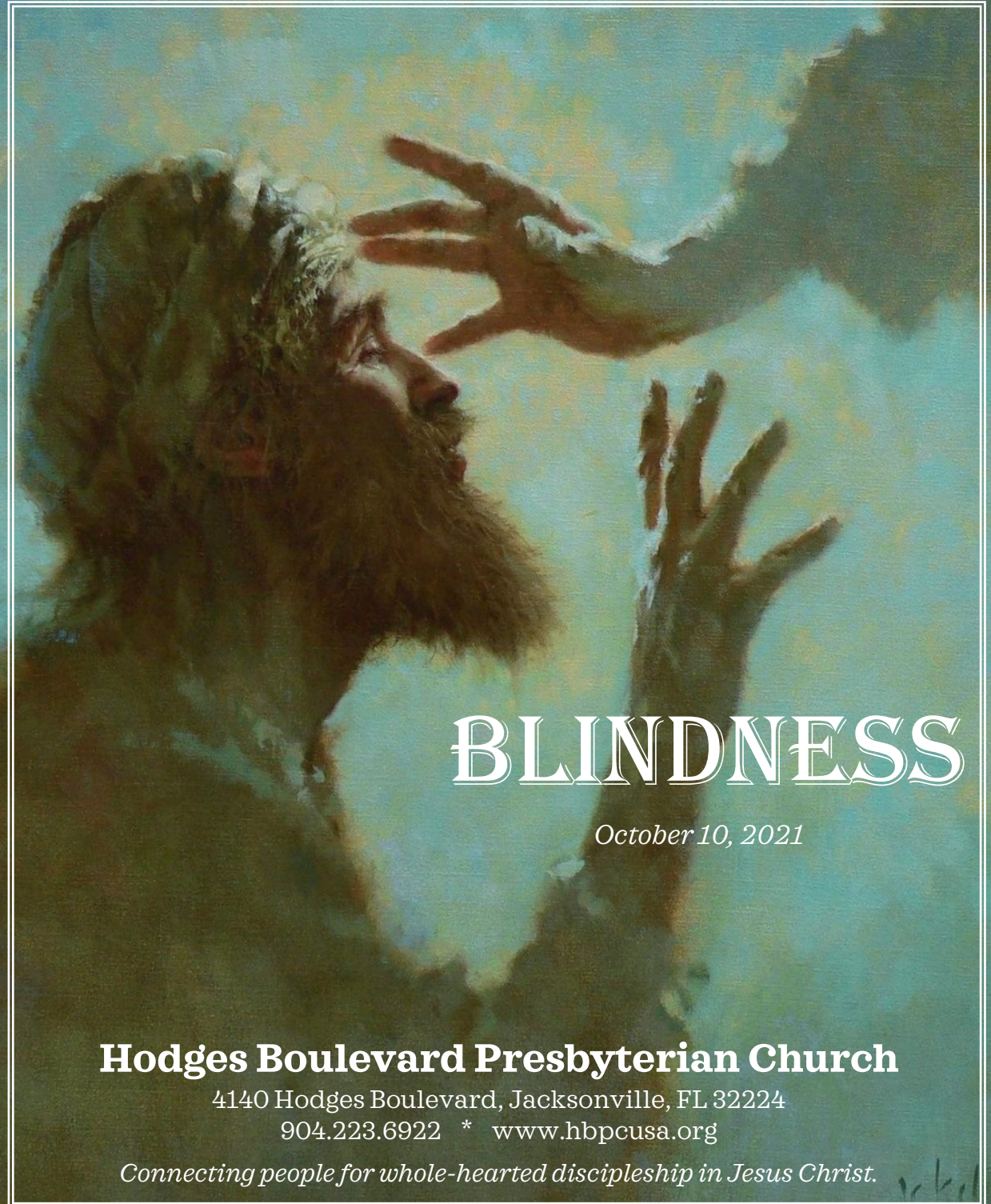
Children's Worship: K-5th Grades
