

Sanctuary Flowers

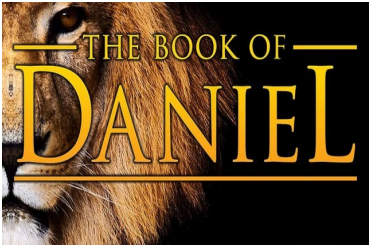

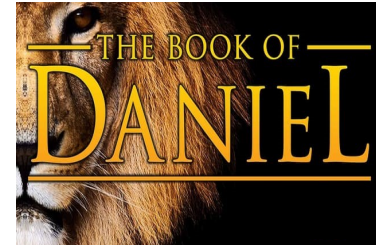
