Sign up begins August 14

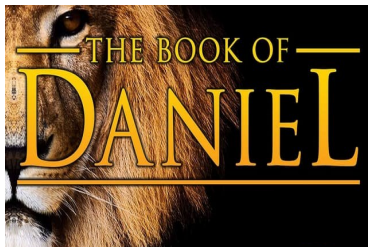

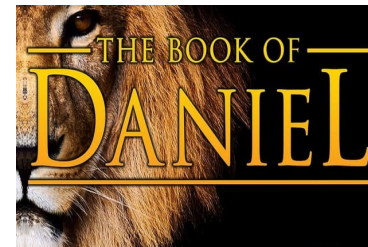
