

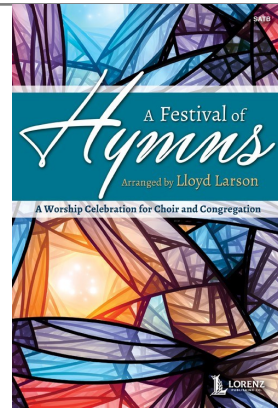


ICE CREAM SOCIAL & KARAOKE

May 22 7:00 pm

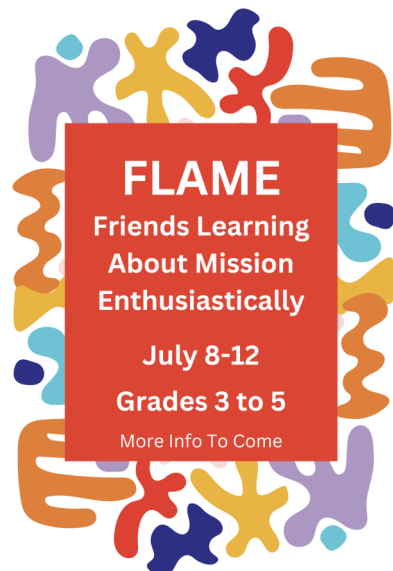
We will finish up Hebrews and have our last discussion. After a break for the summer, we'll resume with a new topic this fall.
