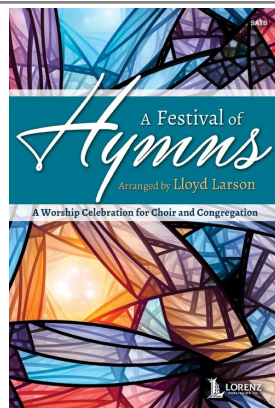


A Festival of Hymns

Children's Worship: K-5th Grades

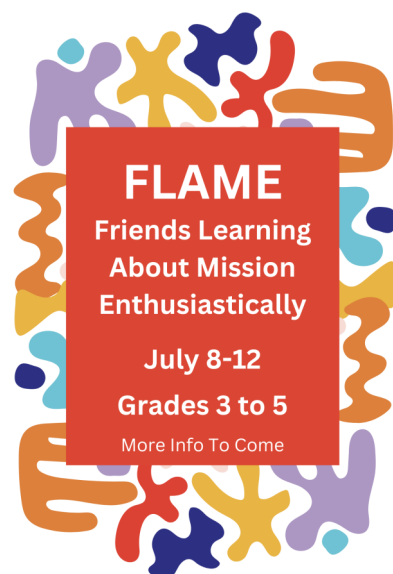
After the Children's Time during the service, staff and volunteers walk the children to Fellowship Hall for special stories and activities geared just for them. Parents please pick them up after worship.
