

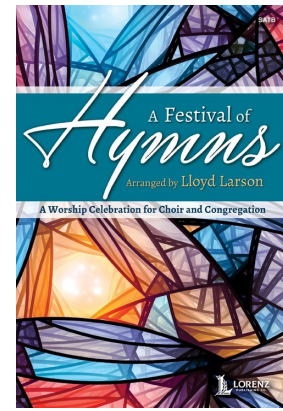
A Festival of Hymns
