

Pastor Jon will be out of town November 4-11. JoAnne will be covering pastoral care needs. She is available at (512) 636-3952.




Pastor Jon recently made a pilgrimage to Turkey. He invites you immediately following the service today in the sanctuary, to come share his experience through pictures.
