Presbyterian Women will provide dessert samples.

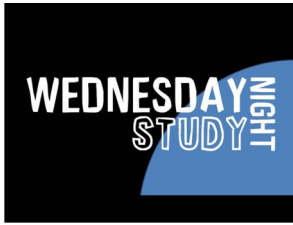
*Contestants should arrive by 5:45 pm to enter.*
